## SBC REVISION HISTORY, ERRATA AND LIMITATIONS

## **Version 5.22 General Release**

### **Enhancements**

## SBC VERSION 5.22 - KNOWN ERRATA AND LIMITATIONS

#### General

- 1. The **SBC** is designed to operate on US versions of Excel and may not work on some international versions, especially non-English language versions due to major functional limitations in the underlying Excel macro engines.
- Performance of the SBC varies on different versions of Excel. This is due to implementation differences of the various Excel versions.
- 3. Closing the **SBC** via the **X** close buttons on some versions of Excel may result in a prompt to save the **SBC\_Macros.xlm** file. Answering **Don't Save** will allow proper termination. Preferable to use the **General / Quit SBC** button.
- 4. **Box Scores** Modifications to the innings labels are not preserved during an Add/Update/Recall Box Score in the current version.
- 5. Running the *SBC* on Excel under a virtual machine (eg: Parallels Desktop, Oracle VirtualBox) can result in degraded performance especially with file-intensive operations such as **One Step Web Site**. This is especially true of the source/destination files reside in the host machine vs the guest machine. In addition, virtual machine features such as shared clipboard can slow down the *SBC*.

## Web Page Processing

- 1. Relative URL addresses cannot be used if the **Player Files Directory** option is activated. Use addresses that result in absolute URL's. Otherwise, incorrect links may be generated in the player files. The **SBC** will test for this situation and alert the user to correct the URL's.
- 2. The Web Composer / Selections / Save Selection As Web Page or Save Selection As HTML Table commands for web pages and HTML tables must be contiguous cell selections.
- 3. Graphics objects for web pages may not match the images pasted on the team worksheet if the user specifies an incorrect file link for the web graphic or if the user modifies the graphic on screen. Printed pages are not affected.
- 4. **Google Fonts Overrides** Primarily used for the base font family for all pages, masthead banners text and content block titles (eg: **Division Standings, Notices, Batting Leaders, Batting Summary**, etc). Different fonts may be specified for each. If a subsequent Google font family override is specified in a cell, it may not work unless it was a Google font specified previously.

### **Windows Platform Specific**

- 1) SBC Help / SBC Info
  - a) Will show Excel version as Excel 2016 for versions 2019 and beyond. This is a result of Excel maintaining the base revision as 16 (same as Excel 2016).

- b) On some Excel versions, the **Help** key does not get mapped to display the **SBC** Shortcuts. The keyboard equivalent: **ctl+alt+?** and toolbar button do work correctly.
- c) The SBC Help / Info command will usually report the underlying operating system as: Windows NT 6.01 regardless of the actual operating system.

## 2) Dialog boxes -

- a) Editable entries such as game numbers, stats, etc. are configured for the allowed data type (eg: integer, real, text, currency, etc.). Not all Excel versions will report an incorrect data type entry with an alert message. Instead, hitting any button to continue will appear that the program is hung. The focus will usually highlight the first entry that is incorrect. The only solution is to visibly check the entries and correct manually.
- b) Dropdown menu lists may have blank slots in the list. This is an anomaly of the Windows dialog processing.
- c) Combination edit/dropdown menu items such as player names, color number/name selection: If the user activates the dropdown menu and decides to not select one of the items, the first item in the list will be selected and will override any user value in the edit box. This is an anomaly of the Windows dialog item processing. If this occurs, hit the **Cancel** button to preserve the original value and retry the command again.

## 3) Printing-

- a) On some older versions of Excel (eg: 2010), the **Print Preview** option results in what appears to be a hang condition with no controls to terminate the mode. This is an anomaly of Excel. To terminate the mode, go to the Windows Task Bar, right-click on the Excel icon, and run the **End Window** command. This will return control to the **SBC**.
- 4) 'No Return or Halt' Alert -

This is a rare occurrence related to the asynchronous nature of how Excel processes ribbon updates. In most cases, simply click **OK** and re-try the command. If that fails, try the steps in the **Ribbon Unresponsive** section of the User Manual.

5) Can't Empty Clipboard Alert -

This is a well-documented problem on older versions of Excel and other Office products on Windows. The internal operation is usually executed correctly. The *SBC* attempts to bypass these instances. If the alert occurs, hit **OK** to continue.

6) Performance on Excel/2013 is slower than on other versions such as Excel/2010 on equivalent systems.

### **Macintosh Platform Specific**

- 1. The **SBC** is supported under Excel 2004 or 2011 only. Other versions lack critical macro functionality for **SBC** operation.
- 2. The **SBC Ribbon UI** is not supported, only the legacy **SBC** menus and toolbar interface.
- 3. Performance of the *SBC* on versions of Excel on the Macintosh platform is inherently slower than on the Windows platform, given similar hardware.
- 4. The **Alignment, Patterns** and **Borders** menu commands and equivalent toolbar buttons are disabled on the Mac versions of Excel prior to Excel/2011 due to bugs in the underlying Excel macros.
- 5. The **About Softball Calculator** command will report the system environment as **PowerPC**, not **Intel** if the version of Excel is running under the Rosetta PowerPC emulator (Example: Excel 2004 under OSX 10.4 on an Intel-based Mac).
- 6. The **SBC** command progress windows are not available as modeless dialogs are not supported in the Mac environment. The command progress is displayed in the status bar at the bottom left of the window.
- 7. The **Check for Updates** function cannot perform the revision test due to lack of internet libraries in the Mac OSX . The user must go to the **SBC** web site and perform this test manually.
- 8. Access to the Online User Manual and *SBC* web site via the menu command/toolbar buttons is not supported. Use the system web browser to access at: <a href="https://sbc.aces-softball.com">https://sbc.aces-softball.com</a>.
- 9. Dialog boxes that have editable entries are configured for the expected type of values. Examples are game numbers expect positive integer values. The dialog manager will alert the user when attempting to enter the wrong data type.

## **Excel/2011 Macintosh Platform Specific**

- 1. Excel 2011 on the Mac implemented a new Ribbon User Interface. This is a hybrid implementation and is not customizable by the *SBC* as compared to the Windows Ribbon UI (2010 and newer). The *SBC* menus will still appear in the menu bar at the top of the window and the *SBC* toolbars are still floating toolbars as in previous versions.
- 2. When executing commands that take a fair amount of time to execute, the contents of the window may appear to jump or flash. This is cosmetic only.
- 3. A script menu may be displayed on the custom **SBC** menu bar. The **SBC** cannot block this. It is not needed for **SBC** operation.
- 4. The **Formula** button on the **SBC** toolbar is initially disabled as the supporting macros under XL2011 are broken. Use the button on the Excel Quick Access Toolbar instead
- 5. The cursor does not always switch to a watch icon during command execution.

6. On completion of program startup, the **SBC** may lose window focus. Clicking on the Team Worksheet window will restore focus.

## **Excel/2004 Macintosh Platform Specific**

 Manual changes to color parameters (eg: banner text colors and fill colors) via the Format / Cells commands will be updated for screen display and printing. However, the changes may not be reflected accurately on generated web pages. This is due to underlying limitations in the Excel/2004 color management system. Modifications using explicit color specifications via the Web Composer / Preferences commands will be accurately represented on web pages.
